WWF Australia is working with the Kija Rangers in Central Kimberly by mapping their breeding habitat and placing buffer burns to protect them from man-made fires. Kija Rangers also created water sources to allow the Gouldian Finches to survive better.

We should protect the Gouldian Finch by not burning the grassland where it lives. It is a beautiful bird found only in Australia that we need to save.
